Project

Students will install and troubleshoot a small enterprise branch network using Cisco simulation software with a Windows server virtualization.

Business Skills Workshop

This workshop focuses on the business or “soft” skills that allow people to interact effectively and productively, skills like collaboration, communication, emotional intelligence, and time management.

3 Courses and 8 College Credits

Foundations in Information Technology

Students learn about configuring operating systems, network configuration, IT security, and troubleshooting.

Client and Server Technician Fundamentals

The course covers installing, building, upgrading, repairing, configuring, troubleshooting, optimizing, and preventative maintenance on desktop, laptop, and server computers. Managing cloud services, storage with Microsoft Azure, monitoring, and troubleshooting services are included. Windows Network Services and Applications are also addressed. Elements of customer service and communication skills are also explored.

Network Installation, Security, and Maintenance

Learn to design, implement, and analyze functional networks by configuring, managing, securing, and maintaining essential network devices. Security layers, authentication, authorization, and accounting are explored, along with network security to protect the Server and Client.
